Felony Malicious Mischief Bond Set

On 10-16-2022 at approximately 08:00 am TPD Officers attempted to contact a suspicious person loitering at a closed business at 1600 South Gloster (Auto Credit). The suspect Bradley Jackson (42 y/o male, Booneville MS) ran on foot when officers pulled into the lot.

Officers quickly located Jackson sitting in the backset of a Nissan owned by Auto Credit and detained him. Evidence was recovered including power tools typically used to cut off catalytic converters. Jackson was arrested and transported to LSO.

On 10-17-2022 Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Sumner set bond at \$15,000 for Felony Malicious Mischief. This case will be presented to the Lee County Grand Jury.
