Aggravated Assault Arrest Made:

On 05-08-2023, Tupelo Police Officers responded to reported stabbing on 1501 East Main St. (Soap N Suds) The victim reported that he was approached by an unknown individual who asked for a ride to Nettleton, MS. After denying the suspect a ride, the victim stated that the suspect stabbed him in the chest. The victim was able to provide officers with a suspect description and officers were able to locate the suspect, who had two outstanding Tupelo Municipal Court Warrants. The suspect was taken into custody and while at the Lee County Jail the suspect was found to be in possession of a felony amount of narcotics.

After further investigation, Lagarry Springer (38 y/o male, Nettleton) was charged with Aggravated Assault and Possession of a Controlled Substance.

Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Weir ordered Springer to be held without bond in relation to the charge of Aggravated Assault. In relation to the charge of Possession of a Controlled Substance, Springer's bond was set at \$5,000. These charges will be presented to the Lee County Grand Jury.
