## ALL INDIVIDUALS ARRESTED ARE PRESUMED INNOCENT UNTIL PROVEN GUILTY

On 06/09/2023, Agents with the North Mississippi Narcotics Unit initiated a traffic stop of a vehicle for traffic violations on South Gloster Street at Barley Court, Tupelo, MS. The traffic stop led to the arrest of the vehicle's driver, Tykerrious Davion Clifton, 18 years of age, from Tupelo, MS, for traffic violations and possession of a controlled substance after alleged fentanyl, a schedule II-controlled substance, was found in the vehicle.

During the booking process at the Lee County Jail, Clifton was found to have a misdemeanor amount of alleged marijuana and additional dosage units of alleged fentanyl concealed on his person. Clifton was charged with trafficking of fentanyl.

On 06/11/2023, Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Jay Weir ordered Clifton to be held without bond.
