Armed Robbery Arrest Made:

On 07-08-2023, Tupelo Police responded to 3 reports of armed robberies in the Mid-Town area of Tupelo. The victims in these cases were able to supply responding officers with a suspect description and details of the property that was taken.

Shortly after the robberies officers in the area attempted to conduct a traffic stop near Cross Town for careless driving. A short vehicle pursuit occurred resulting in the suspect vehicle striking a pole and a suspect fleeing on foot. Officers were able to detain the suspect, Myron Pollard (38 y/o male, Clarksdale) nearby.

An investigation led detectives to charge Pollard with three counts of Armed Robbery.

Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Allen ordered Pollard to be held without bond. These charges will be presented to the Lee County Grand Jury.
