Trafficking of Fentanyl, Possession of Marijuana, and Possession of Firearm by convicted felon Arrest Made:

On 08-16-2023, Tupelo Police Officers were patrolling the area of Cliff Gookin Blvd and Lawndale Street. While in the area Officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for a tint violation. During the course of the stop the driver Emmanuel Coleman (25 y/o male, Tupelo) was found to be in possession of Felony amounts of both Marijuana and Fentanyl Tablets. At the time of his arrest Mr. Coleman, a convicted felon, was found to be in possession of a handgun.

Lee County Justice Court Judge Chuck Hopkins set Mr. Coleman's bond at \$100,000.
