Burglary of a Vehicle Arrest Made:

On 10-25-23, Officers with the Tupelo Police Department responded to the Vasser Drive area in response to a 911 call stating that three suspects were possibly burglarizing vehicles. Upon arrival, Officers detained three individuals matching the description given by the 911 caller. Officers were able to recover several firearms and other miscellaneous property believed to have been stolen in the area.

After further investigation, Tymerius R. Dixon (18 y/o male, Tupelo) was charged with two counts of Burglary of a Vehicle and one count of Directing a Minor to Commit a Felony.

Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Weir ordered Dixon to be held on a \$45,000 bond. These charges will be presented to the Lee County Grand Jury.

The other two suspects involved in these crimes are juveniles and their cases will fall in the jurisdiction of Lee County Youth Court.
