Burglary of a Dwelling Arrest Made:

On 11-16-23, Officers with the Tupelo Police Department responded to a call of a burglary on Maynard Drive. Upon arrival, officers made contact with the property owner and were informed that several items had been stolen from the home.

On 11-19-23, after further investigation, Nijel M. Washington (24 y/o male, Tupelo) was taken into custody by the Tupelo Police Department and charged with Burglary of a Dwelling and Possession of Burglary Tools.

On 11-21-23, Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Weir ordered Washington to be held without bond. These charges will be presented to the Lee County Grand Jury and additional charges are pending at this time.
