Burglary of a Dwelling and Possession of Burglary Tools

On 11/16/2023 TPD Officers responded to the 300 block of Maynard Drive in reference to a residential burglary. It was determined that possible suspects were already in custody.

Before this incident was reported TPD Officers attempted to stop a dark colored passenger car on Cliff Gookin Blvd. The vehicle fled from officers, and the vehicle stopped around S. Green Street, where a foot chase ensued. Officers were able to arrest two of the occupants, Damarcus Williams (26 y/o, Shannon, MS) and LaMarco Tate (18 y/o, Shuqualak, MS). Stolen items were recovered from the suspect vehicle.

On 11/17/2023 Tate and Williams were both charged with burglary of a dwelling and possession of burglary tools. Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Allen denied bond for both subjects. Additional charges are possible.
