False Pretense Arrest Made:

On 9-07-23, officers with the Tupelo Police Department took a report stating that a suspect had cashed stolen and altered checks at multiple banks in Northeast Mississippi. One of these transactions took place in the jurisdiction of Tupelo Police Department.

On 12-27-23, after further investigation, Larry D. Tutor Jr. (49 y/o male, Tupelo) was arrested and charged with one count of False Pretense.

On 12-28-23, Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Allen ordered Tutor to be held on a \$5,000 bond. These charges will be presented to the Lee County Grand Jury.
