Felony Fleeing and Narcotics Arrest Made:

On 12-28-23, Officers with the Tupelo Police Department contacted the driver of a vehicle that was blocking the parking lot exit of a business on McCullough Blvd. As officers were contacting the driver, narcotics were detected in the vehicle. At that time, the driver of the vehicle fled the scene and after a pursuit the driver was taken into custody. At the time of arrest, the driver was found to be in possession of a felony amount of narcotics and had two active Lee County Circuit Court Capias Warrants for his arrest.

On 12-28-23, Jordan Hill (28 y/o male, Okolona) was charged with Felony Fleeing and Possession of a Controlled Substance.

Tupelo Municipal Court Judge Allen ordered Hill to be held without bond. These charges will be presented to the Lee County Grand Jury.
