Garbage Cans

Please remove your roll-out garbage container from the curb within 12 hours of garbage collection and be sure to pick up any trash that may have been dropped accidentally during pick up.

Pets

Please do not allow your dogs, cats, or other pets to run loose or make excessive noise. Pet pens and enclosures must be kept clean, sanitary and free from odor.

Livestock

Please follow restrictions on keeping animals in certain areas and keeping enclosures clean, sanitary and free from odor.

Lawn Parking

Please do not park any vehicle in your front yard except in paved parking areas.

Junk Litter

Used, discarded, worn out materials, or manufactured goods, may not be stored on your property. This includes old washers, dryers, freezers, refrigerators, tires, etc.

Commercial & Recreational Vehicles

Vehicles larger than $\frac{3}{4}$ ton, buses, trailers exceeding 15 feet, and heavy equipment may not be parked on the street or in your yard except for loading, unloading, or construction. (RV's, boats, and campers may not be parked in the street or in your front yard).

Parking of Small Trailers

Please make sure all small trailers meet the proper setbacks and placed a concrete pad when being stored on your property.

Lawn Maintenance

Property owners must regularly mow the grass in their yards, as well as any vacant lots that they own.

Screening of Dumpsters

Please make sure all commercial garbage dumpsters are placed inside a view obscuring enclosure.

Screening of Junkyards

Please make sure all junkyards are screened in with a view obscuring enclosure.

Junk Vehicles

A car or truck that does not display a current tag and inspection sticker, and/or physically incapable of operation, is a junk vehicle. Such vehicles may not be parked in the street or in your yard. They may only be kept in a completely enclosed building or garage.
